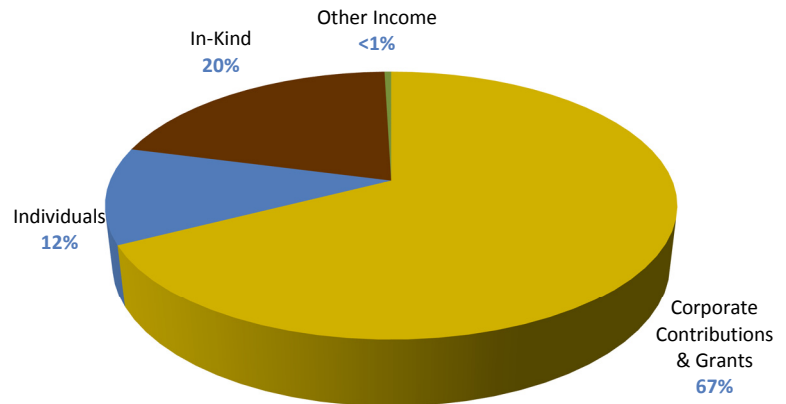
For over twenty years, we have offset the deficiencies that otherwise hold back exceptional students from attaining a college degree. We look at the big picture by nurturing our students with new experiences, new relationships, and new educational opportunities that will allow them to succeed. Since 2007, 86% of PFF students have either graduated from college within 6 years or less, or they are persisting and are expected to graduate within that timeframe. We are proud of those results and happy to share additional proof that our model works:

- 100% of the Class of 2016 successfully graduated from high school and matriculated to college.
- Out of 39 graduates, 90% were accepted into one of their top three college choices.
- The Class of 2016 earned over \$7 million dollars in outside scholarships.
- As an organization, PFF has given out over \$1 million dollars in scholarships through our Scholarship Match and special scholarship programs.
- PFF students ranked within the top 10% of their schools’ graduating classes, and more than 80% of the students who enter PFF complete the program.
- PFF graduates matriculate to colleges such as The University of Virginia, The College of William & Mary, Virginia Tech, James Madison University, Cornell University and North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University, to name a few.

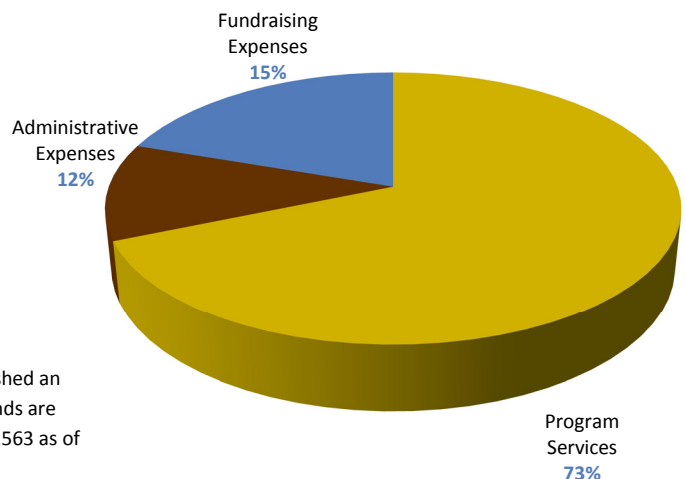
