About the Role

The College Access Fellow is a seasonal summer position that plays a key role in supporting high school students as they pursue college and career goals. Fellows provide mentorship, supervision, and hands-on program support in a peer-adjacent capacity. This role is ideal for college students or recent graduates committed to youth success and educational equity.

What You'll Do

- Support PFF College Access Managers by assisting with supervision and day-to-day support of high school students in our summer program.
- Work alongside staff to help facilitate weekly personal and professional development workshops.
- Assist with supervision and student support during the overnight summer institute.
- Support students in external summer internship placements through consistent monitoring and mentorship, including progress check-ins, documentation of key updates, participation in site visits, and communication of student needs or concerns to program staff.
- Help monitor the summer program hotline and route transportation, attendance, or general questions to appropriate staff.

Qualifications

- Current college student in good academic standing or recent college graduate.
- Strong communication skills, including the ability to maintain consistent notes and document student progress following intern check-ins.
- Communicate effectively with students and staff.
- Ability to work independently, organize and prioritize work, and meet deadlines.
- Interest in youth development, mentoring, or college access programming.
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation required.
